CareDx Announces New Chief Commercial Officer Todd Whitson

(Nasdaq: CDNA), a molecular diagnostics company focused on the discovery, development and commercialization of clinically differentiated, high-value diagnostic surveillance solutions for transplant patients, today announced that Todd Whitson will join CareDx as the Chief Commercial Officer.
